Parish Farewell Mass/Reception - Join us at 10:30am for a bi-lingual Mass to celebrate Fr. Dennis' last Mass at St. Anne. There will be a reception following in St. Sebastian Hall.

Stewardship - During June, we have celebrated key moments in the life of the Church — Pentecost, the Most Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi — culminating today with the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. St. Peter, the first Pope, was chosen by Christ as the rock on which the Church would be built. The Catechism tells us that because of the faith he professed, Peter remains the "unshakeable rock of the Church." Despite his human weaknesses, Peter's loyalty, repentance, and leadership make him a powerful model of stewardship. St. Paul, once a persecutor of Christians, became one of the Church's greatest evangelists. Though they were martyred separately, tradition holds that Peter and Paul were in Rome at the same time, and their shared witness and sacrifice tie them closely together in Church history. They embody two vital aspects of stewardship — Peter in his faith and leadership, and Paul in his zeal and wisdom. As stewards, we are called to follow their example — to build the Church through our commitment, to overcome our failures through God's mercy, and to proclaim the Gospel with courage. Like Peter and Paul, we are invited to give all we have for the sake of Christ and His Church.

Co-Responsabilidad - San Pedro, el primer Papa, fue elegido por Cristo como la roca en la que se construiría la iglesia. El catecismo nos dice que debido a la fe que profesaba, Pedro sigue siendo la "roca inquebrantable de la iglesia". A pesar de sus debilidades humanas, la lealtad, el arrepentimiento y el liderazgo de Peter lo convierten en un poderoso modelo de administración. San Pablo, una vez perseguidor de cristianos, se convirtió en uno de los mayores evangelistas de la iglesia. Aunque fueron martirizados por separado, la tradición sostiene que Peter y Paul estaban en Roma al mismo tiempo, y su testigo y sacrificio compartidos los unen de cerca en la historia de la iglesia. Encarnan dos aspectos vitales de administración: Pedro en su fe y liderazgo, y Pablo en su celo y sabiduría. Como mayordomos, estamos llamados a seguir su ejemplo: construir la iglesia a través de nuestro compromiso, superar nuestros fracasos a través de la misericordia de Dios y proclamar el evangelio con coraje. Al igual que Peter y Paul, estamos invitados a dar todo lo que tenemos por el bien de Cristo y su iglesia.
